Scope and Content Note:

FOIA 2000-1335-F contains memorandum of conversations that took place between President Bush and various Hungarian officials during the President's trip to Hungary in July 1989. These officials include 2000-1335-F 1 2000-1335-F 2 Hungarian President Bruno Straub, Prime Minister Miklos Nemeth, and Minister Imre Poszgay. A significant amount of material responsive to this FOIA is contained in the National Security Council (NSC). Although these files are listed, it should be noted that most of these documents are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.
