Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2004-1019-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. 2004-1019-F 2 FOIA 2004-1019-F contains materials from agencies and individuals regarding various aspects of baseball. The Alphabetical Name File contains correspondence to and from individuals to the Vice President. The subject file contains correspondence; memoranda; news clippings; and brochures from the general public, Congress, and Vice President Bush's staff. Many of these documents are requests for the Vice President's autograph or are invitations to participate in activities that range from local little leagues to the major baseball franchises. The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by individual staff members and offices. Events such as ceremonies at the National Baseball Hall of Fame and the All Star Game of 1988 are covered in these files.
