Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2005-1003-F are a systematic, and all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2005-1003-F contains materials from the National Security Council pertaining to all of the NSC meetings held during the George H. W. Bush Administration with dates ranging from February 10, 1989 to December 03, 1992. These meetings were held in a classified environment, and these records relate 2005-1003-F 2 to foreign policy issues that faced the administration. The NSC Meeting Files contain correspondence, memoranda, talking points, and agendas for NSC meetings and were maintained by the National Security Council Office. The subject matters discussed during the NSC meetings pertain to foreign policy issues during the administration. Examples of subjects included are policies pertaining to Western and Eastern Europe, the Persian Gulf, South America, Nuclear Matters, and Arms Control.
