Scope and Content Note:

White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Categories contain correspondence, memoranda, news clippings, and brochures from the general public, the Cardinal Cooke Guild, and the 2006-0673-F 1 2006-0673-F 2 Bush administration. These records concern the request of the Cardinal Cooke Guild for a presidential visit or message at the organization's annual awards luncheon. Presidential messages were sent for 1989, 1990, 1991, and 1992. The Name File contains a handwritten note from Vice President Bush to Cardinal Cooke following the vice president's attendance at the 1982 Alfred E. Smith Dinner. The Vice Presidential Staff and Office Files contains a speech made by Vice President Bush at the 1982 Alfred E. Smith Dinner in which he mentions Cardinal Cooke, who had invited him to the dinner. The speech includes handwritten annotations by Vice President Bush.
