**Scope and Content Note:**

The materials in FOIA 2006-1150-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by individual staff members and offices. The files of Philip D. Brady, Vice President Chief of Staff, consist of memos from Philip Brady, Doug Wead, Debbie Hutton, and Thomas Melady. Some of the materials from Thomas Melady are closed under PRM restrictions. Thomas Melady acted as an advisor to Vice President Bush during the Presidential Campaign of 1988. Other memoranda and letters contain letters written by the Vice President to influential Catholic figures regarding public policy and Catholic concerns.
