Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2007-0142-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2007-0142-F consists of materials related to Khosro Moghadam or his father, Lt. General Moghaddam, Aide-de Camp to His Imperial Majesty/The Shah of Iran. Lt. General Nasser Moghaddam also served the Shah as the Chief of Intelligence of the Military Forces and as head of SAVAK, the domestic security and intelligence service of Iran. Lt. General Moghaddam was murdered by the Khomeini Government in 1979 and his family was given asylum in the United States. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical File category contains letters and a telegram. The letters are between the White House and Mr. Khosro Moghadam, a copy of a general letter from Eugene Tighe, Lt. General, USAF (Ret), Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), and letters between Lt. General Moghaddam and Lt. General Eugene Tighe.
