Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2020-0208-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2020-0208-F contains a Strategic Petroleum Reserve option paper from January 1990, the Strategic Petroleum Reserve Annual/Quarterly Report from February 1992, a 1985 letter from a constituent to Vice President Bush suggesting that U.S. grain be exchanged for Mexico Oil and added to the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, a 1987 letter from a constituent asking then VP Bush to use the Strategic Petroleum Reserve Project to reduce the nation's \$2.5 trillion debt, agenda and materials for a Domestic Policy Council Meeting on July 21, 1986 discussing the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, and a memo discussing a Domestic Policy Meeting to be held on August 5, 1986 discussing the Strategic Petroleum Reserve.
