Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2004-1923-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2004-1923-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including Maureen Santini, a White House correspondent for the Associated Press (1979-1985) and The New York Daily News (1987-1992), Marlin Fitzwater, Press Secretary, and the Press Office, Office of the Vice President. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical Files contain a letter from Maureen Santini thanking Mrs. Bush for lunch and a tour of the White House. The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence from Maureen Santini to President and Mrs. Bush. The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence between Maureen Santini and Marlin Fitzwater concerning an interview during the Persian Gulf War in 1991 and a cassette tape of an interview conducted by Ms. Santini with Vice President Bush in his office at the White House in July of 1988.
