Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2024-0784-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. The WHORM Subject File categories contain memoranda and correspondence between former Senator Barry Goldwater (R-AZ), President Bush, and administration staff members regarding Goldwater's recommendations for candidates (including himself) to serve on various boards and commissions, (e.g. the Barry Goldwater Scholarship and Excellence in Education Foundation and the Air Force Academy Board of Visitors) and requests for President Bush's support for various endeavors such as the National Historical Intelligence Museum and the Tuskegee Airmen Scholarship Fund distinguished Achievement Award Dinner. The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence from Senator John Glenn (D-OH) expressing his view on various domestic issues; a copy of public remarks given by former President Richard Nixon entitled "The Promise of Peace"; and notes and memoranda pertaining to Mrs. Bush attendance at the memorial service for Bush family friend Neil Mallon.
