Rill and Chairwoman of the Federal Trade Commission Janet Dempsey Steiger. The Bush Vice Presidential records and the Federal records contains similar materials. The WHORM Subject File categories contain memoranda and correspondence related to the Federal Trade Commission's (FTC) work and government antitrust policies. The Staff and Office Files contain memoranda, correspondence, press releases, Statements of Administration Policy, and proposed legislation pertaining to the FTC and anti-trust policy as well as materials related to the appointment of Janet Dempsey Steiger to the Federal Trade Commission. A significant amount of materials consist of FTC reports prepared for the Congress.
