Allen, Frank Carlucci, William P. Clark, Alexander Haig, Jeane Jordan Kirkpatrick, Paul Laxalt, Edwin Meese, Donald Regan, George Shultz, and William French Smith. WHORM Subject Files of Note: WHORM Subject File FG002-39 which contains correspondence related to former Presidents. FG002-39 is the code for President Reagan. Relevant case numbers include: 91737, 250314, 266293. WHORM Subject File GI002, Gifts to the President, Case Number 300616 which contains correspondence between Presidents Reagan and Bush regarding the opening and dedication of the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library on November 4, 1991. The Staff and Office Files contain records relating to John Poindexter, Robert McFarlane, George Schultz, Caspar Weinberger, Edwin Meese, Frank Carlucci, Jeane Kirkpatrick, and the Iran-Contra Affair. Document types include memorandums, letters of recommendation, personal notes, processing forms, disclosure forms, resumes, questionnaires, requests, invitations, and published articles. The bulk of records are from the White House Counsels Office.
