Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2017-2149-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2017-2149-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including the White House, Department of Agriculture, Department of Health and Human Services, and the Social Security Administration. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical Files contain letters from the general public and responses from federal agencies concerning food stamps. The majority of these letters are from members of the public seeking White House assistance with the food stamp and social security programs. The WHORM Subject File categories contain general correspondence concerning food stamps and welfare. The Staff and Office Files contain reports on food stamp programs, including a feasibility report on an electronic food stamp program in Pennsylvania. The Bush Vice Presidential subject file contains a letter and articles from a member of the public concerning food stamps and the oil industry. The Bush Vice Presidential Staff and Office files contain a report from the Task Force on Regulatory Relief concerning food stamps.
