FOIA 2019-0114-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including members of Congress and interest groups concerning the US relationship with Tibet and the Immigration Act of 1990. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical Files contains a letter from an individual about immigration and jobs. The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence concerning the U.S. position on the United Nations resolutions concerning Tibet and China. The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by individual staff members and offices. The majority of these records concern the development and administration views on the Immigration Act of 1990. There are a few records concerning US/Tibet relations.
