## **Records on Military Preparedness; Rapid Response**

**Scope and Content Note:**

The materials in FOIA 2020-0365-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2020-0365-F contains letters of correspondence from the general public regarding their thoughts, opinions and proposals for U.S. Military preparedness. For example, one gentleman's letter of proposal outlines in detail his suggestion that there be the creation of a new White House position entitled "Special Assistant to The President for Military Preparedness." This FOIA request also contains National Security Council and Secretary of Defense memoranda discussing various Significant Military Exercises and a booklet from the Quayle vice presidential records regarding new world order, peace and military preparedness.
