The materials in FOIA 2023-1056-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2023-1056-F contains materials related to Secretary of the Interior (and former U.S. Representative from New Mexico) Manuel A. Lujan, Jr. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical Files contain memoranda and correspondence from constituents either supporting or opposing Secretary Lujan and his policies related to the environment-such as the proposed protection of the Spotted Owl. The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence, memoranda, etc. from candidates seeking positions within the Department of the Interior, environmental issues pertaining to the protection of the Spotted Owl, dispensation of American Indian lands, etc., personal notes between Secretary Lujan and President Bush. The Staff and Office Files contain memoranda, correspondence, and reports pertaining to environmental issues, invitations from Secretary Lujan for the President and/ or First Lady to speak to environmental interest groups or conferences, and annual reports from the Department of the Interior.
