Scope and Content Note:

The materials in FOIA 2024-0484-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2024-0484-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including White House Counsels Office and the American Enterprise Institute (AEI), an independent conservative non-profit organization which was founded in 1938 as the American Enterprise Association (AEA). The organization researches government, politics, economics, and social welfare. The Staff and Office Files contain agendas, drafts, handwritten notes, letters, memoranda, papers, remarks and talking points. Counsel to the President C. Boyden Gray's Subject Files document a session Gray was moderating at the 1991 AEI Annual Policy Conference. Talking points, draft remarks, handwritten notes, letters and copies of papers to be presented show the subject to be governmental regulation. The Federal Records contain forms, letters, and memoranda. Ann Windham Wallace's files at the Office of Consumer Affairs consist of more generic letters, forms and memoranda from the AEI regarding invitations to various events and information gathering.
